- Sensitivity analyses to address data limitations

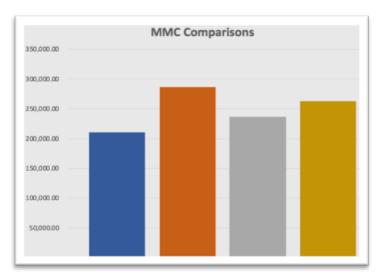

- Focuses Data, validated Information leading to better Knowledge





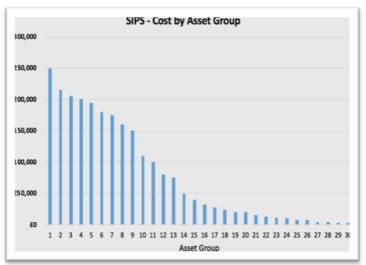
