- Does one need BIM to operate digitally and is it an integrated part of a blockchain contract. Could one just have very simple operating instructions and then on completion it would enable payment and contract fulfilment mechanisms?
- Reinvention of BIM models for every project could there just be opensource overlays and people add to them as necessary
- Accord project have templates that are open source
- Examples of where the toddler steps are being taken :
  - Framework Alliance Contracts
  - Pre-Commencement Contracts
- Should contracts include BIM or not ?
