'What we need to do differently to make Offsite construction a viable option?'

One of the key points was that a number of offsite operations were not adopting end to end manufacturing processes but were just carrying out construction in a shed rather than in the open air. To truly drive efficiency will have to breakdown activities into true line assembly process.

- Is there a place for the small offsite manufacturer in all this? Need to do what you are going to do very well if you are going to compete.
- What about social value and local employment where does it feature in large scale offsite manufacturing One solution is the opportunity for sub assembly areas where the actual houses are to be put up so providing employment in the local area.
- There will be a quality revolution as more offsite solutions are adopted
